



MEMORANDUM OF
STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR JOINT OIL SPILL COMBAT
IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA INCLUDING BRUNEI BAY FOR
BRUNEI-MALAYSIA

This Memorandum of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Joint Oil Spill Combat in the South China Sea including Brunei Bay for Brunei-Malaysia is made on this Tuesday of November 7 of 1995 by and between the Government of Brunei Darussalam, represented by the Department of Marine of Brunei Darussalam; and the Government of Malaysia, represented by the Department of Environment, Malaysia.

WHEREAS, based on the decision reached at the Official Level Meeting on the Oil Spill Contingency Plan and Malaysia - Brunei Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) which was held in Kuala Lumpur, on the 1st October 1993, Government of Brunei Darussalam and the Government of Malaysia, has agreed to adopt and sign the SOP, as Attachment 'A' for the purpose of strengthening the oil spill combatting capability in the event of oil spill incidents and the establishment of a regional oil spill response system in the South China Sea including Brunei Bay for both countries.
